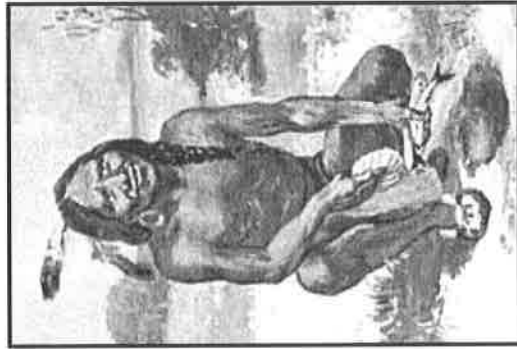


Who was Squanto?

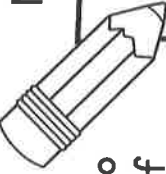
Squanto, was a Native American who lived a long time ago. He was part of the Patuxet tribe. He helped the pilgrims during their first winter

Squanto was born around 1585. In 1605, he was captured and taken on a ship to Britain. He learned to speak English in Britain. When he was returned home, he was captured again! This time he was sold as a slave in Spain. Squanto escaped and went back to North America. While he was gone, his whole tribe had died from illnesses brought by explorers from Europe.

Squanto became a guide for the pilgrims. He taught them about planting and fishing. He helped them to trade with other Native Americans. The Pilgrims might not have survived without his help.
